

## KASNEB AND KISM COURSES

Rongo University, on the one hand, and Kenya Accountants and Secretaries National Examination Board (KASNEB) and Kenya Institute of Supplies Management (KISM), on the other hand, have entered into a partnership that mandates the University to prepare candidates for the two bodies' examinations. Within the framework of this partnership, Rongo University prepares candidates for six professional qualifications, one associate professional qualification and three diploma qualifications. These are:

- Certified Public Accountants ( CPA)
- Certified Secretaries (CS)
- Certified Information Communication Technology (CICT)
- Certified Investment and Financial Analysis (CIFA)
- Certified Credit Professionals ( CCP)
- Certified Procurement and Supply Professional of Kenya ( CPSP-K)
- Associate in Procurement and Supply of Kenya ( APS-K)
- Accounting Technicians Diploma (ATD)
- Diploma in Information Communication Technology (DICT)
- Diploma in Credit Management
